**Extension Regional Specialist, Behavioral Health**

OEE invites applications and nominations for four Extension Regional Specialists, Behavioral Health. This is a full-time, twelve (12) month, non-tenure track faculty position on the Extension instructor track (instructor, senior, master) or the Extension professor track (assistant, associate, professor) dependent upon the candidate's academic credentials and professional experience. The faculty appointment, evaluation, and promotion standards are centered around the three core duties of extension faculty – educate, create, and connect ([Faculty Educate Create Connect Supplemental PDF \(1\).pdf](#)). Candidates are sought with interests that complement and expand upon current initiatives and education activities in OEE.

The CAP Team in the Department of Human Development and Family Studies and Colorado State University Extension (CSUE) are looking for four full-time Regional Extension Behavioral Health Specialists to work with the CAP Team to provide in-the-field stress management information and education to farmers and ranchers, to prevent emergencies including suicide, to be innovative in addressing the reluctance of many farmers and ranchers to seek and follow through with counseling, and to provide training for rural behavioral health providers and community stakeholders.

The primary office location for these four positions are anticipated to be housed within Regional Extension Offices with specifics to be determined based on candidate location and available resources. While this position is eligible for a hybrid work arrangement, the individual is expected to maintain a balance establishing a presence in the primary office, to effectively carry out the duties of the position. The work schedule will vary, and occasional nights and weekends will be required.

**Required Job Qualifications:**

- Completed master's degree. Conferred degree in a behavioral/mental health field.
- Three years' clinical experience working with clients in crises.
- Must have a valid driver's license or the ability to obtain a driver's license or access to a licensed driver by the employment start date.
